Slavery in Southport

Students will discuss plantation and city slaves in Brunswick County from Colonial to Civil War era. We will discuss slaves on the water as well as the underground railroad along the blockade. Students will dye shirts using indigo dye.

Civil War Home Life

How did people live when war was at their front door? Learn about how families made ends meet during hardships and the loopholes they found to stay alive. We will look at death and mourning traditions following this war. Students will read letters written to soldiers from families at home then create their own letter.

Native Americans

Students will complete a crossword puzzle then move to the classroom to learn about transportation, food-ways and housing of the Eastern Woodland Native Americans in the Lower Cape Fear. Students will make their own dugout canoes before we walk to Indian Trail Tree to see their ingenuity first hand and discuss folklore and oral traditions. While in the park students will write and illustrate their own creation stories.

Tragedy
